K-24 GERMICIDAL TEAT DIP

This is an iodine product used as an aid in controlling mastitis.

DIN: 00504807

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

Nonylphenoxy poly (ethyleneoxy) ethanol-iodine complex 10%
(providing 1% minimum w/v available iodine)

DIRECTIONS: Immediately after each cow is milked, dip the teats in undiluted product. When a cow is being dried off, continue the teat dipping once a day for 1-2 weeks. The teat dip solution in the dip cup should be changed if it becomes visibly dirty, if sediment is introduced or if brown colour fades very noticeably.

NOTE: Do not use for cleaning and/or sanitizing milking equipment. Do not dilute - product is ready to use. It contains a built-in colour indicator. As long as the iodine colour remains, its germ-killing power is working. Contains glycerine.
