K-24 G GERMICIDAL TEAT DIP

This is an iodine product used as an aid in controlling mastitis.

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

10% nonyl phenoxy polyethoxy ethanol-iodine complex
(providing 1% titratable iodine)

DIRECTIONS: Immediately after each cow is milked, dip the teats in undiluted teat dip. When a cow is being dried off, continue the teat dipping once a day for 1-2 weeks. The teat dip solution in a dip cup should be changed if it becomes visibly dirty, if sediment is introduced, or if brown color fades very noticeably.

NOTE: Do not use for cleaning and/or sanitizing milking equipment. Do not dilute – product is ready to use. It contains a built-in colour indicator. As long as the iodine color remains, its germ-killing power is working. Contains glycerine.
